

Windows To Go enables users to boot a self-contained copy of Windows 8 from a USB storage device

Windows To Go considerations:

- Hibernate and sleep are disabled by default
  - Internal disks are offline
  - TPM is not used
  - Windows Recovery Environment is not available
  - Push Button Reset is not available
  - Create Windows To Go in Windows 8 Enterprise only
- To create a Windows to Go workspace, complete the following high-level steps:
    - Insert USB drive
    - Verify WIM file location
    - Launch Windows To Go Creator Wizard
    - Select your USB drive
    - Select the .WIM image
    - Optionally, encrypt the USB drive with BitLocker
    - Wait for the creation process to complete, which could take up to 30 minutes
