Background: Diabetes mellitus (DM) remains a primary chronic disease in the world, including in Indonesia. A poor lifestyle that includes smoking habits, stress, and lack of physical activities will further increase the incidence of DM. This study aimed to explore smoking habits, stress, and physical activity in relation to DM incidence in Indonesia.

Methods: A total of 12,110 respondents from 13 provinces in Indonesia were interviewed and evaluated in a cross-sectional national-based population study in Indonesia. Multivariate binary logistic regression analysis was used to calculate the adjusted odds ratio value with a 95% confidence interval.

Results: Of the 12,110 respondents, 9,154 (75.59%) were \square 45 years old and 6,704 (55.36%) were low physically active. Respondents who were exposed to cigarette smoke (AOR = 0.73, 95% CI = 0.57-0.94, p < 0.05) and perform high active or vigorous physical activities (AOR = 0.81, 95% CI = 0.67-0.9, p <0.05) were significantly related to DM.

Conclusion: Smoking habits and physical activity were highly associated with DM but not stress. Furthermore, improving health promotion and preventive activities on DM was needed and organized by primary health care.

This is good study with concise abstract and reasonable background and clear methods and results to make Indonesian knowledge base.

Why don't you discuss more about Indonesian primary health care around diabetes in Introduction or Discussion to make suggestion about health promotion and preventive activities on Diabetes Mellitus?

Author responses #1:

Done. Thank you for your comment. We have agreed and added in discussion section. The revised manuscript with highlight have uploaded.

Reviewer report #2:

- This is a study using national data, and it deals with important topics, but much improvement is needed in analysis methods and interpretation. It is recommended to seek advice from statisticians or epidemiologists who have dealt with such kinds of data.
- Men and women might be very different in many ways. It is recommended to analyze separately for men and women, rather than adjusting for gender as a confounder.
- Table 2: Exposure variables seem to be treated differently for crude OR and adjusted OR. For example, there is only one crude OR but three adjusted ORs for education variable. Please use the same category in crude analysis and adjusted analysis.
- Authors described in the results as below, but I do not understand their interpretation. It is a misinterpretation that the odds of diabetes are 0.27%. Please consult an expert for data analysis and interpretation.

"Based on the results of the study, response with smoking habit had the odd to develop DM of 0.27% (AOR = 0.73, 95% CI = 0.57-0.94, p < 0.05)..."

Author responses #2:

- Thank you for your suggestion. For analysis methods and interpretation have revised following your suggestion.
- For gender in our data actually means sex (female and women). The data didn't collecting a gender. So we have changed gender to sex. Thank you for your suggestion.
- We have corrected Table 2. Before we analysed multivariate, the first step we have analysed a bivariate model to select risk factors and/or confounder into the next step. We apologise for this serious mistake and have corrected in those table with highlight.
- Done. We have corrected our interpretation especially AOR <1. "Based on the results of the study, respondents with smoking habit had lower odds of DM (AOR = 0.73, 95% CI = 0.57-0.94, p <0.05)...", and "With the same smoking pattern, we found that female showed significantly protective against DM (AOR = 0.73, 95% CI = 0.57-0.94, p < 0.05)..".
