The abstract contains 233 words (guidelines for authors states a range of 150-200 words). In the abstract authors does not state that it is a cross-sectional study. There are only 3 keywords (guidelines for authors states a range of 5-8 words). The aim was set clearly. The methods used are not properly described. In the text missing methods of selection of participants. The authors do not describe the exclusion criteria of the participants. The results are processed clearly and concisely. The discussion is sufficient. The set aim was met. I recommend publishing the article after processing the comments in the review (range of abstract, study design in abstract, number of keywords, methods of selection of participants, exclusion criteria - if they have been defined).

Thank you for your comment. We have revised manuscript with highlight have uploaded. For abstract, we have revised following the journal guidelines that updates 200 words including stated study design was cross-sectional. For keywords in abstract section was added 5 words such as diabetes self-management, psychometric properties, diabetes mellitus type 2, T-DSMS, criterion validity. Then the methods of selection of participants have revised. We have distributed to all patients meeting the selection criteria upon arrival at selected ambulatory nurse, during office hours. Out of 730 personally distributed questionnaires, 700 questionnaires were completed, giving a response rate of 96%. We have exclusion criteria in this study such as patients with terminal stage of illness, cognitive impairments or inability to complete the questionnaires. Revised manuscript has uploaded with highlight in the link of website of this journal.

Thank you very much. We have added and uploaded our revised manuscript regarding the data collection process.

All participants were recruited aged ≥ 20 years old, type 2 diabetes mellitus, diagnosed at least three years before, recent HbA1c blood test, written and understood the Thai language, and participated willingly in the study. Patients with terminal stage of illness, cognitive impairments or inability to complete the questionnaires were excluded. The questionnaire was distributed to all patients met the selection criteria upon arrival at selected ambulatory nurse, during office hours. Out of 730 personally distributed questionnaires, 700 questionnaires were completed, giving a response rate of 96%.

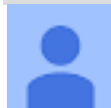
