We'd like to send responses to reviewer's comments for our manuscript. We completed a revised manuscript that uploaded a version of our manuscript highlighting any revisions made.

Reviewer report #1:

Please confirm/clarify the case definitions of breast cancer. You have stated that breast cancer is measured by mammography, regardless of less appropriate words (measured), mammography itself has inherent limitations, particularly for the young woman or woman with smaller breast size. Thus it may be less likely to detect mass in these populations. In addition, the accepted gold standard for cancer diagnosis is pathological examination of biopsy specimens, thus not all mammographic mass might eventually end up as breast cancer (malignant). Please justify your standing, and include arguments that perhaps limit your generalization based on this definition of breast cancer.

Author responses #1:

Thank you for your comment. All data in this study were obtained from four types of questionnaire books in the household Survey Questionnaire Book, which can be assessed at <https://www.rand.org/labor/FLS/IFLS/download.html>. Based on the IFLS-5, the variable of breast cancer was assessed using a mammogram by a medical doctor in oncology. Then, subjects were classified into the two categories of Yes and No based on the IFLS-5 data.

The revised manuscript has uploaded with a highlight in the link to the website of this journal.

Reviewer report #2:

We did not see anywhere on the text, the mention about the percentage and the absolute count of women with breast cancer.

Author responses #2:

Thank you very much. We have added and uploaded our revised manuscript and have provided in Table 1. Regarding a small number of breast cancer cases, we have explained in limitation in this study. We have uploaded our revision with the highlight—a small number of participants incidence who diagnosed with breast cancer in this study. The participants completed questionnaire in this study were all female, mostly married, and a had low-level education. Consequently, selection bias may affect the generalizability of the findings since women and persons with low-level education were generally not aware of breast cancer signs and symptoms. Hence, the actual lifestyle of breast cancer patients in the population is most probably higher than estimated here.

Moreover, we have also explained in our manuscript in the discussion section. Although breast cancer cases were small, this was a study involving a large sample size spread across 13 provinces in Indonesia so that it represented Indonesia both economically and socio-culturally.

Reviewer report#3

The discussion could be improved with a more in-depth explanation regarding the association of lower educational level with breast cancer. Is this related to the elementary graduate having limitations to access health care, and thus cant get mammography or less likely to know about breast cancer? Not to mention that the range of CI of the elementary school is wide (and only significant in adjusted OR).

Author responses#3

Thank you for your suggestions. A more in-depth explanation about the association's educational level with breast cancer has added in our manuscript in the discussion part. We have also uploaded our revision with highlight.

In paragraph 2: Our findings showed that women with elementary and junior high school were significantly associated with breast cancer. Educational level is known to relate to the knowledge and attitudes of breast cancer (16). In line with the previous study, the lower educational level had lack of awareness and financial

limitations to check their breast as early as possible when they felt something abnormal in their breast (e.g. pain, swelling, nipple discharge, etc.). The low level of educational level among participants of this study affected their inadequate understanding of early signs and symptoms of a disease and early prevention efforts of the disease, including their lack of knowledge for early breast cancer screening. Also, women feel frightened abandoned by their spouse if they are found to have breast cancer. Meanwhile, higher education had a greater chance of being diagnosed with early-stage breast cancer (17).
