The reason is that the use of Levenshtein Distance algorithm can correct some typoindicated keywords correctly, so that system can find documents that have the keywords." "Fig. 5 shows that recall value of testing with spelling correction and query expansion is higher than that without them. The reason is that the use of spelling correction can display documents with typoindicated keywords while the use of query expansion can find documents that have similar meaning with keywords from user's query."
