THE SOCIALITY OF EMOTION: AN EXAMPLE OF RESEARCH TOPIC

Questions to explore:

- How do we compensate for the absence of personal touch/contact and a decreased level of rapport in online learning?
- What pedagogical strategies are required to cater for learners' emotional development and investment?
- How does emotion come into play in every facet of learning mediated through online platforms?
- How much attention has been directed at the role of positive and negative emotions in learning?
- How do we capitalize on the affordances of digital space to make learning more emotionally nurturing ?
