RINGKASAN

Students majoring in English Education are often faced with various challenges, both in terms of academic achievement and professional skills development. Solution that is often used is mentoring programs, where students receive guidance from experienced lecturers or mentors. This study aims to analyze the needs of mentoring program for students majoring in English Education. Through this research, it is expected to identify specific needs that can support students' academic success and professional development. The results of this study will be the basis for the development of mentoring programs that are effective and relevant to the needs of students.

This research will use a qualitative approach with a case study design. The research subjects are students and lecturers in the English Education department. Data will be collected through in-depth interviews, focus group discussions, and questionnaire surveys. Data analysis will be conducted using thematic analysis method to identify the main themes that emerge related to mentoring needs. The research instruments to be used include: Semi-Structured Interviews, Questionnaire, Focus Group Discussion Guide.

The outcome of this research is articles published in the Script Journal: Journal of Linguistics and English Teaching (<https://jurnal.fkip-uwgm.ac.id/index.php/Script>) an international journal by the Department of English Language Education, Universitas Widya Gama Mahakam Samarinda and International Journal of Education Insight (IJEI) from Doctoral Program of Education Science Universitas Ahmad Dahlan. This fundamental research (penelitian dasar) has technology readiness level one, namely concept formulation and/or technology application .

LATAR BELAKANG

Students majoring in English Education are often faced with various challenges, both in terms of academic achievement and professional skills development. Although educational institutions have provided a range of academic support, there is still a gap between students' needs and the support provided. One form of intervention that is often used is mentoring programs, where students receive guidance from experienced lecturers or mentors. However, mentoring programs are often poorly structured or do not meet the specific needs of students, which limits their effectiveness. The main problem that will be investigated in this study is the lack of understanding of students' specific needs in mentoring programs, which has an impact on the program's sub-optimality.

The main objective of this study is to analyze the needs of a mentoring program for English Education students. By understanding the specific needs of students, it is hoped that important elements that must be present in an effective mentoring program can be identified. This research also aims to provide data-based recommendations for the development and implementation of a mentoring

program that is more relevant and beneficial to students.

This research has great urgency given the important role mentoring plays in students' academic and professional success. Without an in-depth understanding of students' needs, existing mentoring programs run the risk of being less effective and not providing maximum benefits. Thus, this research is expected to make a significant contribution in improving the quality of mentoring programs in English Education, which in turn will support the achievement of broader educational goals.

TINJAUAN PUSTAKA

Mentoring is a dynamic, reciprocal relationship that fosters personal and professional development through guidance, support, and knowledge sharing. According to Koven, mentoring involves a more experienced individual providing advice and encouragement to a less experienced mentee, facilitating their growth and skill acquisition in a specific field [1]. Rombeau et al. emphasize that effective mentoring not only enhances the mentee's competencies but also contributes to the mentor's own learning and satisfaction, creating a mutually beneficial experience [2]. Furthermore, Olsen highlights the importance of structured mentoring programs, which can significantly improve outcomes for both mentors and mentees by establishing clear goals and expectations [3]. While the benefits of mentoring are well-documented, challenges such as mismatched expectations and communication barriers can hinder the effectiveness of these relationships. Overall, mentoring is a vital process that supports individual growth and fosters a culture of continuous learning within organizations.

Mentoring can significantly benefit English education students by enhancing their pedagogical skills, fostering professional development, and improving student engagement. Research indicates that mentoring relationships provide critical support, helping students navigate the complexities of teaching and curriculum design, which is essential for effective English instruction [4]. Additionally, mentoring fosters a sense of community and collaboration among educators, which can lead to improved teaching practices and increased confidence in their abilities [5]. Moreover, studies highlight that mentorship can facilitate reflective practice, allowing students to critically assess their teaching methods and adapt to diverse learning environments [6]. This reflective process is crucial in English education, where understanding student needs and promoting literacy skills are paramount. However, it is important to note that the effectiveness of mentoring can vary based on the quality of the mentor-mentee relationship and the specific context of the educational environment [7], [8]. Overall, structured mentoring programs can play a vital role in shaping competent and confident English educators.

Conducting a needs analysis for mentoring programs aimed at English education students is essential for several reasons. First, it helps identify specific gaps in knowledge and skills that students face, ensuring that the mentoring provided is tailored to their unique needs and challenges [9]. This targeted approach can enhance the effectiveness of the mentoring experience, leading to improved educational outcomes. Moreover, a needs analysis can

facilitate the alignment of mentoring objectives with the broader educational goals of the institution, fostering a more cohesive learning environment [10]. It also allows for the incorporation of diverse perspectives from both students and mentors, which can enrich the mentoring process and make it more relevant to current educational practices [11]. Additionally, understanding the specific needs of English education students can help in the development of resources and training for mentors, ultimately leading to a more supportive and effective mentoring framework [6]. Lastly, it can aid in evaluating the program's success and areas for improvement, ensuring continuous development and adaptation to changing educational landscapes [12]. Thus, a thorough needs analysis is crucial for creating impactful mentoring programs.

Innovative teaching strategies are essential for creating an engaging and effective learning environment for students. They help teachers to develop creative approaches to instruction, as well as help students become independent learners. It is presented and based on the following roadmap.




Figure 1. Research Roadmap of English Education Department

Review on Relevant Studies

The focus of this research is on the identifying students need on mentoring program. Below are several related articles which have similar focus as this research.

First, it is an article entitled Need Analysis for Teaching English in Early Childhood Education Students written by Wati & Ramadhan (2023). This article describe the needs in learning English in PG PAUD students. It utilizes Qualitative descriptive approach with Questionnaires and direct interviews for data collection. The result show that the Students' English mastery is relatively low.

Second, Smith-Washington, V conducted a research entitled A Qualitative Analysis of Experienced: Teachers' Ongoing Need for Mentors in 2023 [13]. The need analysis of mentoring programs has focused on training mentors, matching mentors with experienced teachers, and supporting special education teachers to reduce attrition rates. The objectives of the research were: investigate if experienced teachers still need mentors and explore the impact of mentoring on special education teachers. Technique of collecting data was individual interview with a former study participant. Data analysis was conducted through thematic analysis by manual coding.

Third, it is an article entitled Exploring Mentees' Needs from a Mentoring Program: Towards the Development of a Mentoring Toolkit conducted by Tangco-Siason et al. in (2022). This study aimed to find out mentees' needs from a mentoring program, mentor characteristics that are considered desirable by mentees, and to develop the mentoring toolkit. It was based on a developmental research design. Through purposive or selective sampling, it involved eight (8) informants. Focus Group Discussion (FGD) and mentoring chat records were used to collect data, which was then analyzed using NVivo Software under the guidance of the qualitative content analysis technique. Mentees' needs included study abilities, thinking skills, resource management, teaching skills, personal and family concerns, and articulated mentors' desirable characteristics, according to part one (1) of this study. The five (5) components of the toolkit that was developed were listed in the second (2) portion of this study. Targets, Ideas, Plans, and Supplements were the four (4) parts of the toolkit. The toolkit also includes six (6) mentoring blocks, and the physical attributes, objectives, content, usefulness, and self-help aspects of the toolkit were all evaluated outstanding ($M = 3.92$). Mentoring programs are useful in determining the needs of mentees as well as providing a basis for developing materials that are useful to both mentors and mentees.

METODE PENELITIAN

This study used a quantitative approach with a survey method. Survey research is a quantitative method used to collect data from a predefined group of respondents, aiming to gather insights on opinions, behaviors, or characteristics. It typically involves structured questionnaires or interviews, allowing researchers to analyze trends and patterns within a population. According to Nolte et al., survey research is particularly valuable in understanding complex phenomena by capturing diverse perspectives in a systematic manner [15]. Cronin et al. emphasize that the design of surveys can significantly influence the quality of data collected, highlighting the importance of clear questions and appropriate sampling techniques [16]. Brewer et al. discuss the role of survey research in evaluating program effectiveness, noting that it can provide actionable insights for decision-making [17]. However, Butts points out potential limitations, such as response bias and the challenges of ensuring representative samples, which can affect the validity of findings [18]. Overall, survey research is a powerful tool for data collection, but careful design and execution are crucial for reliable results.

Survey research is a systematic method for collecting data from a population through structured questionnaires, enabling researchers to generalize findings from a sample to a broader context. This approach is prevalent in health sciences and social sciences, where it helps quantify attitudes, behaviors, and knowledge.

Key Components of Survey Research

Design and Methodology: Effective survey research begins with clear research goals, followed by literature reviews, sample selection, and question design. Pretesting and modifications are crucial for ensuring validity and reliability [19], [20].

Data Collection: Surveys can be administered online, providing economical access to participants, though they often suffer from low response rates [21]. The choice between open-ended and close-ended questions impacts data richness and analysis complexity [19].

Analysis and Reporting: Post-collection, data must be analyzed with attention to biases such as

nonresponse and social desirability. Structured reporting is essential for clarity and objectivity [21], [22]. While survey research offers valuable insights, it is not without challenges, including methodological flaws and biases that can affect the validity of findings [22] Researchers must navigate these issues to enhance the rigor and applicability of their results.

The survey method was chosen because it can collect data from a large sample in a relatively short time, thus allowing researchers to get an overview of the needs of mentoring programs among English Education students. The subjects of this study are students majoring in English Education. The sample will be selected using stratified random sampling method to ensure balanced representation based on semester level (beginning, middle, end) and gender. The target sample is 100 students to ensure the data obtained is representative enough. The instrument of this study is questionnaire, it aims at measuring measure students' perceptions regarding certain aspects of mentoring, such as academic guidance, emotional support, and professional development. The questionnaire will be distributed both online and in paper form to accommodate students' preferences. Participants will have two weeks to complete the survey. Reminders will be sent to non-respondents to increase the response rate.

Responses from paper questionnaires will be entered into a digital database. All data will be anonymized before analysis. Data obtained from the survey will be analyzed using descriptive statistical techniques, that is using descriptive statistics to present survey or questionnaire data, such as mean, median, and frequency distribution. This helps in illustrating needs and wants of the students. After the data being analyzed, the findings will be interpreted in the context of the research objectives, with a focus on identifying key trends, differences between subgroups, and potential implications for the design of mentoring programs. Any significant patterns or relationships will be highlighted and discussed in relation to the existing literature.
